Commercial Building Fires: why do they kill firefighters? A program that looks at non-residential buildings and why fires in these buildings are so deadly to the fire service, and what we can do to prevent more deaths.



Instructor: Chief Ken Erickson, Retired



A 40-year veteran of the fire service, Chief Erickson has served as a Chief Officer in five departments (North Attleboro, Duxbury, Walpole, Laconia, and Belmont Fire Departments) ranging in size from 24 to 40 firefighters, both career and combination. He holds a BS in Fire Administration and an AS in Fire Science from Providence College. Chief Erickson is a graduate of the UMASS Chief Fire Officer training program, the Maryland Fire Rescue Command, and Staff program, and has attended the National Fire Academy numerous times. He has taught seminars at the NH Fire Academy, State of Vermont, Lakes Region Mutual Fire Aid, and Lakes Region Community College. He has fought and commanded hundreds of fires during his career.
